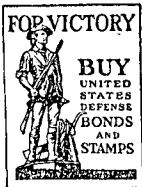

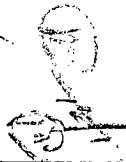

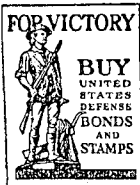

Subject **DR. RAYMOND RAPHAEL SACKLER** registered LB 187, Bklyn., NY 7/1/41 and on 5/1/45 classified 2-A until 6/30/45. Dr. SACKLER interned at Harlem Hospital, NYC from 9/1/44 to 5/31/45. Dr. SACKLER married **BEVERLY SACKLER** on 1/29/44 at Yonkers, NY. **BEVERLY** born 5/13/24 at Bklyn., NY. Subjects presently reside at 716 Ocean Parkway, Bklyn., NY. Description of Dr. SACKLER set forth.

Report of Special Agent James J. Stratford Jr., dated March 23, 1945 at Boston, Massachusetts.

**DETAILS:**

The Selective Service file of subject reflected that he registered under the name of **RAYMOND RAPHAEL SACKLER** at Local Board 187, 568 East Fifth Street, Brooklyn, New York. He was assigned Serial No. S-93 and Order No. S2375. Subject was then residing at 3845 18th Avenue, Brooklyn, New York and registered on July 1, 1941. Subject gave his age as 21, having been born on February 16, 1920 at Brooklyn, New York and listed his occupation as a medical school student. The record reflected that the name of the person who would always know his address was that of **ISAAC SACKLER, 3845**

18th Avenue, Brooklyn, New York, his father. Subject stated that he was attending the University of Georgia School of Medicine at Augusta, Georgia. Subject listed the following information concerning his education:

He stated he attended New York University and received a B.S. Degree. He stated he attended Anderson College of Medicine, where he studied medicine for two years. Anderson College is located in Glasgow, Scotland.

In view of the fact that the subject was studying medicine he was classified 2-A by the Local Board on August 19, 1941. The file reflects the subject took a physical examination on February 26, 1942 and was qualified for non-combatant service only, due to poor vision. Subject again took a pre-induction physical on July 14, 1944, at which time he was declared physically fit and acceptable for general military service.

On April 19, 1945 the subject's case was reopened and he was reclassified 1-A. On May 1, 1945 subject was reclassified 2-A after a hearing of the board, this classification to be in effect until June 30, 1945.

Selective Service Form 42-A was submitted by the Harlem Hospital, 137th Street and Lenox Avenue, New York City, stating that the subject was an interne and they requested that he be given a deferment so that he might finish out his internship. This form stated that the subject's internship was due to run from September 1, 1944 until May 31, 1945.

The records reflect that the subject's file was sent to Local Board 47 at Middlesex County, Cambridge 38, Massachusetts, on June 30, 1944. The file reflects that the subject graduated from Middlesex University School of Medicine in July, 1944.

On May 1, 1945 there was a notation in subject's file which reflected that he was married in January, 1944; that he has one child.

Dr. JACOB GOLDEN, Assistant Medical Superintendent, Harlem Hospital, 137th Street and Lenox Avenue, advised that they have on their staff as an interne, an individual by the name of RAYMOND R. SAGLER. Dr. GOLDEN checked the records of the hospital, which reflected that the subject was given a post as an interne at the Harlem Hospital upon his graduation from Middlesex University School of Medicine on September 1, 1944, and that the internship usually continued for a period of approximately one year.

MARY MONAHAN, in charge of personnel records, Harlem Hospital, made available the records concerning the subject, which reflected approximately the same information as has been set out previously. The records reflect that the subject was married on January 29, 1944 and his wife's first name was BEVERLY.

The marriage records, Borough of Manhattan, under number 20920, volume 3, reflect that on January 24, 1944 a marriage license was issued to RAYMOND R. SACKLER and BEVERLY FELDMAN. Information contained on the records reflected that RAYMOND SACKLER's place of residence was given as Beth Moses Hospital, 404 Hart Street, Brooklyn, New York. His age was given as 23, having been born on February 16, 1920 at Brooklyn, New York. His occupation was given as that of a medical student. His father's name was given as ISAAC SACKLER, born in Austria and his mother's maiden name as SOPHIE GREENBERG, born in Poland. He stated he had no previous marriages.

Information contained on the marriage license concerning BEVERLY FELDMAN reflected that her residence was New York University School of Medicine, First Avenue and 26th Street, New York City. Her age was given as 19 and date of birth as May 13, 1924 at Brooklyn, New York. Her father's name was given as DAVID FELDMAN, born in Russia, and her mother's maiden name was ANNA BAKERMAN, born in Russia.

The records reflect that the date of marriage was January 29, 1944 at Yonkers, New York, and the ceremony was performed by City Judge CHARLES W. BOOTE. The license also reflects subjects were again married on April 2, 1944 at Brooklyn, New York by Rabbi JACOB BOSNIAK.

A check of the indices of the New York Field Division fails to reflect any additional information concerning the subjects, which has not previously been supplied to the office of origin.

On October 1, 1958, the passport file of Beverly Sackler was made available to Special Agent Joseph A. Connors, Jr., by the Passport Office, United States Department of State.

Passport Number 1212677 was issued to Beverly Sackler on August 19, 1958.

Her application was dated July 16, 1958, at New York City. She listed her birth date as May 13, 1924, at Brooklyn, New York. Her permanent residence was listed as 170 Birch Drive, Roslyn, New York. She stated she planned to leave New York City about August 8, 1958, on the ship "Liberte" for a four to five week trip to France, Italy, Switzerland, Belgium and England to accompany her husband. Her father was listed as David Feldman, born October, 1888, in Russia, and who has been living in the United States since 1908, and who at the time of application was living at 140 Ocean Parkway, Brooklyn, New York. Her mother is Anna Feldman, born 1889, in Russia, and who at the time of application was residing in the United States since 1908, and who was residing with her father. Both of her parents are American citizens.

She stated that she was married to Raymond Sackler on January 29, 1944. She stated her husband was born in Brooklyn, New York, on February 16, 1920, and at the time of the application they were living together. She was described

In her application filed July 16, 1958, Mrs. Sackler did not answer any questions relating to present or past membership in the Communist Party (CP).

The CP, USA, has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

On July 19, 1960, the passport of Beverly Sackler was renewed at New York, New York. Mrs. Sackler advised the Passport Office that she intended to depart from New York, New York, on August 15, 1960, via Pan American World Airways, for a four week stay in England and France with her husband.

On October 24, 1960, by means of a pretext, it was determined by a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that Beverly Sackler was then residing at 170 Birch Drive, Roslyn, New York.

On October 28, 1960, by means of a pretext, a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation was advised that Beverly Sackler did not travel to Europe during the past summer.

advised Special Agent Eugene J. Hinder that a reservation had been made by Beverly Sackler for flight 100 to London on July 15, 1960. This reservation was subsequently cancelled by the customer and another reservation was made for flight 2 to London on July 16, 1960. Mr. Zuck stated that Mrs. Sackler failed to appear for this flight.

Mr. Zuck further stated that in conjunction with the aforementioned reservations to London, return reservations had been made for Mrs. Sackler on flight 115 from Paris on August 4, 1960, and flight 101 from London on September 15, 1960. On each occasion, Mrs. Sackler failed to appear for the flight. In brief, Mr. Zuck stated that according to the records of Pan American World Airways, Beverly Sackler did not travel to Europe.

On January 4, 1945, the confidential source, who was in a position to furnish reliable information, advised that Beverly Sackler, transfer number 13909, was transferred from the Kensington Club of the CP to Boston on April 14, 1944.

They reside at 170 Birch Drive, Roslyn, New York. They intended to depart the United States on July 8, 1968, for a six week visit to England, France and Italy for the purpose of pleasure and business. On July 16, 1968, a Special Agent, Federal Bureau of Investigation (SA, FBI), ascertained by pretext, that Beverly and Raymond Sackler, 170 Birch Drive, Roslyn, New York, were at that time in Europe and would not return to the United States until about the middle of August, 1968.

Beverly Sackler was born on May 13, 1924, Brooklyn, New York, and is a housewife. She is described as white, female, 5 feet 3 one-half inches, brown hair, brown eyes.

Raymond Sackler was born on February 16, 1920, Brooklyn, New York. He is white, male, 5 feet 9 one-half inches, brown hair, green eyes, wears glasses, light complexion. He is employed as a medical doctor and has a business office at 15 East 62nd Street, New York, New York.
